DIGITAL IDENTIFICATION STANDARDS RELEASED FOR PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) wishes to inform all public bodies and stakeholders, including provincial and district administrations and their respective Digital Transformation Officers (DTO), that the PNG Government Digital Identification Standards 2024 have been released for public consultation.


We invite all stakeholders to submit feedback on the draft digital identification standards, which will be used to drive the development of a safe, reliable, and interoperable digital identity system that will enhance security, privacy, and accessibility.

This public consultation will be used to gather input on key aspects of digital identification standards, including security protocols, privacy measures, interoperability frameworks, usability, accessibility, and governance, all the while ensuring this standard reflects the needs and concerns of all public bodies and stakeholders, including citizens and businesses.
