FIRST PAPUA NEW GUINEAN TO UNDERTAKE A PHD IN DIGITAL GOVERNMENT

Port Moresby, As Papua New Guinea marks 50 years of Independence, we also celebrate new milestones that shape our future.

I am proud to announce that Mr. Russell Woruba, Deputy Secretary for Digital Government and Information Delivery at the Department of Information and Communications Technology, has been accepted to study for a PhD in Digital Government at the University of Information Technology and Management in Poland.

He is the first Papua New Guinean to take on this level of study in Digital Government. His research will focus on Digital Public Infrastructure, which will help make government services more open, efficient, and easier for people to access.
